*This year, our Concessions Managers were amazing and led the band to a VERY successful concessions' season. (Thank you!) Despite this success, our overall band balance is approximately \$2,700 lower than it was at this time last year. (June 2022 --\$93,372.26 vs June 2023 -- \$90,708.36) As treasurer, I feel the need to point out this difference. To those who see our overall balance and think it's a high amount, please note that expenditures for our band were over \$80,000 for the year and exceeded receipts by approximately \$300. The band was impacted also by restrictions during the COVID-era. **A successful fundraising year will be important for SY 2023-2024 and in future years.***
